What is Diversity Youth Manager Project?

Diversity Youth Manager Project is co-founded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union, under the KA2 Strategic Partnerships in the field of education and training action for cooperation for innovation and the exchange of good practices.

The Project will be implemented with 4 partners from 4 countries: United Kingdom, Romania, Italy, and Spain. The project will develop Diversity Youth workers to be able to empower the disadvantaged young people to take charge of their own life.

Diversity Youth Worker will have all the skills to facilitate innovative youth work and use technology and digital skills to enhance the offer and programs.
